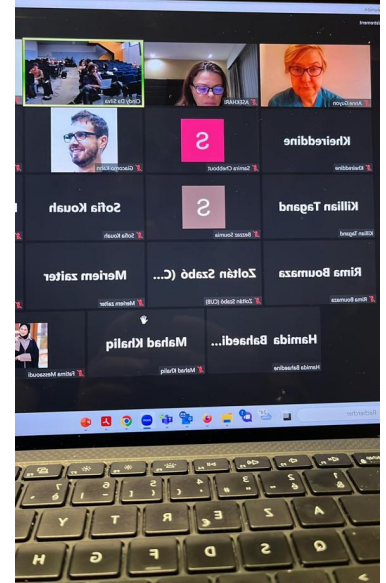
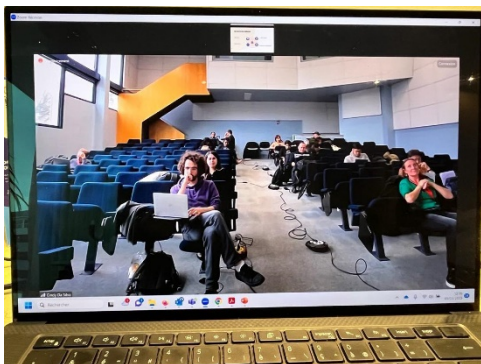

On November 9, 2023, the University Lumière Lyon 2 and the IUT Lumière Lyon 2 organized a Workshop on “Data and AI in Health” held by the Research, Transfer, and Innovation center (Pole RTI) and “DECISION AND INFORMATION for PRODUCTION SYSTEM” Research laboratory (DISP).

The Workshop brought together around fifty people in person and remotely over the day (researchers, doctors, ICT industries, embedded engineers, machine learning experts) to discuss and share their views on the Digital Health organization.
