This meeting was instrumental in setting the project timeline for completion in January 2025, along with clear deliverables and expectations.

The meeting showcased pilot cases, deconstructed prototypes, and delivered updates on existing courses.

By the end of the week, the consortium had successfully defined an evaluation Kirkpatrick model, tailored to the specific needs of the DIGIHEALTH-Asia project. This model will enable a comprehensive assessment of the effectiveness of implemented curriculum. The consortium further had discussion about how this model incorporates rigorous quality assurance measures to ensure the continuous improvement of the DIGIHEALTH-Asia project.

Towards the end of the plenary meeting, we organized a workshop to discuss the research progress of the project and draw up a plan to pursue publications. It was agreed among the participants that each of the three pilot case teams (Thailand, Pakistan, Mongolia) will aim to develop a review journal paper based on the individual healthcare application addressed in the pilot study, looking at the health challenges facing the region. Furthermore, it was suggested that the whole project consortium will aim to prepare a research journal paper to disseminate the achievements of the project. Several potential venues were suggested, but follow-up discussions will be needed to confirm the choice of journals. Paper developments will be managed on Overleaf.
